Wanted: Kindergarten Students for September 2017

If you missed our Kindergarten registration, please call our office at 609-693-3131 ext. 110 to set up an appointment. If your child will be turning five (5) years old on or before October 1, 2017, they are eligible to attend our full day kindergarten. Original birth certificate, immunization records, 2 proofs of residency (current tax bill, current utility bill, etc.) and photo ID of the parent/guardian registering the child are required upon registration.

*All children entering the district will be required to have a physical. Forms are available and are to be returned to school no later than July 17, 2017.
